



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

We are committed to work in a manner that conserves our Environment and to conduct our Confidential Shredding service in an environmentally responsible way. CCS Cork has established this Environmental Policy to communicate awareness and understanding of Environmental considerations throughout all aspects of our business.

Environment Leadership

CCS Cork has appointed Deborah Wills to develop and implement company initiatives to help us achieve our Environmental goals and targets and to communicate our policies to all interested parties. Environmental aspects are considered and discussed as part of our weekly management meetings.

It is our policy to:

1. Fully comply with all local, national, and European environmental legislation.
2. Forward 100% of our shredded paper for recycling and divert non-recyclable materials from landfill through processes such as recovery.
3. Fully commit to continually improving our environmental performance by assessing and monitoring our processes, particularly in the efficiency of our Transport department.
4. Ensure that our operations, services, and products used do not create unacceptable risks to human health or the Environment.
5. Assess the discharges and waste generated from our sites/premises and their effects, if any, on the Environment and community.
6. Work with suppliers to promote and ensure, where possible, that products are sourced from sustainable and ethical sources.
7. Work with partners who ensure that our products enter the Circular Economy, wherever possible.
8. Provide support, education, and training so that our employees work in such a way that reflects best practice.
9. Regularly review our Environmental practices and policy.
